Our speaker will be:

John Dockall, PhD, RPA

His topic will be:

“Cistern Water Storage Features at Frost Town, Texas
(41HR982)”

He will focus on both the brick lined cisterns and the two barrel cisterns, their excavation/investigation, and their importance in interpreting the material culture at 41HR982 in downtown Houston, Texas

The 2015 archeological survey by PAI (Prewitt and Associates, Inc.) included the excavation of 20 mechanical trenches south of Buffalo Bayou of Houston, of which 15 were dug inside of the Frost Town area. This resulted in the discovery of 28 historic cultural features (24 of the features were found in the Frost Town area), obtaining archeological evidence from three historic archeological sites including the Republic of Texas Arsenal Block (41HR1166), Peter Floeck tract (41HR1167), and Frost Town (41HR982). The results of the 2015 trenching confirmed the presence of significant archeological remains across a large portion of the former Frost Town community.
