## The Pine Ridge Preceramic Project: A Summary of 3 Field Seasons at August Pine Ridge, Belize

Mike McBride Project Director, Pine Ridge Project

Mike McBride will be speaking on the archaeological sites at August Pine Ridge, a sand quarry in the Central American country of Belize where workers recovered Paleoindian and Archaic artifacts dating as far back as 13,000 years ago. The earliest spear points show similarities to Clovis points in North America, while the later Archaic artifacts, including large numbers of ground stone bowls and other utensils, point to Caribbean influences.

The ongoing research of the Pine Ridge Preceramic Project (PRP) continued with our annual field season in May-June, 2025. Controlled excavations and shovel testing broadened the research area with sampling data for more extensive geoarchaeological analysis. Working with our local workers and their private collections, we have added dozens of new Paleoindian and Archaic Period artifacts to our catalog. In this presentation, we summarize the remarkable assemblage of diagnostic artifacts recovered, along with preliminary interpretations of placement within the broader episodes of the earliest human migrations into the Americas.

Mike McBride is a board member of the Gault School of Archaeological Research and helped initiate the Pine Ridge Preceramic Project in 2023. He also leads the Crying Woman Ranch Project in Kerr County focusing on the site's Paleoindian occupations.


